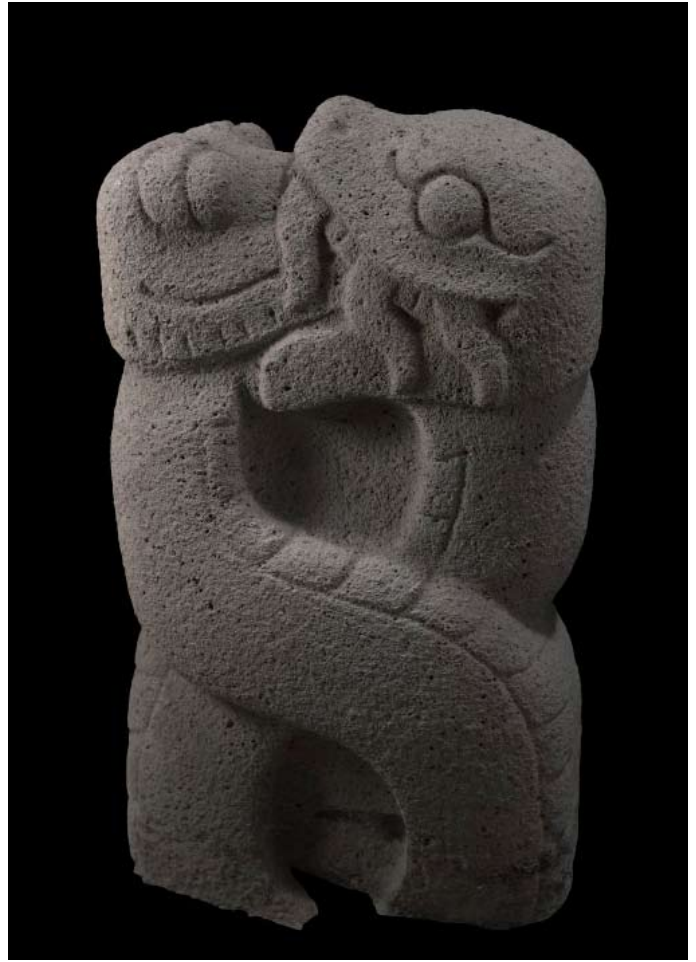




The sculpture was made out of two scans, this is the process of registering the two scans in Geomagic Software.



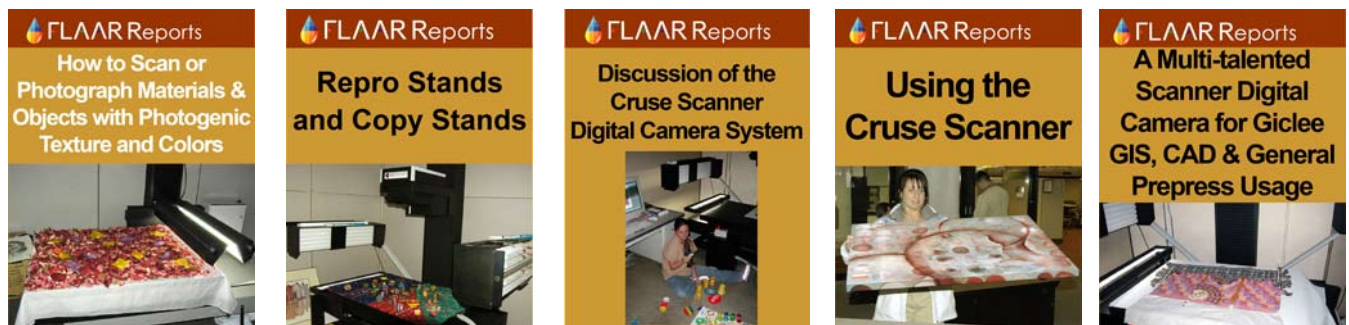
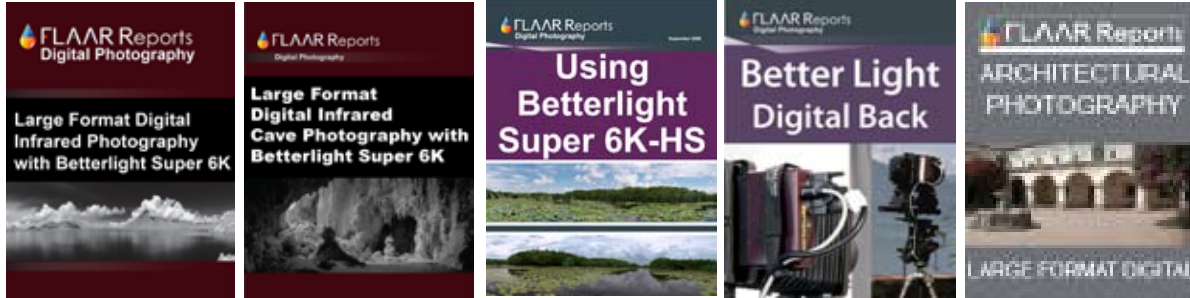
*The first picture shows the scans fully registered and the second picture shows the sculpture as a closed object.*

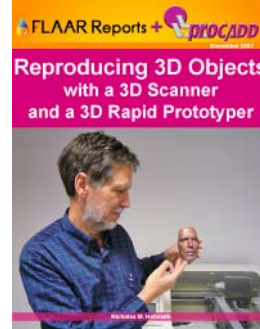
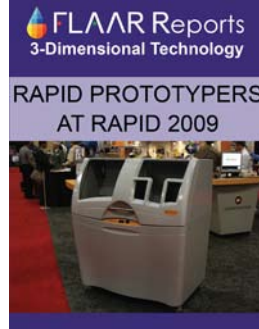
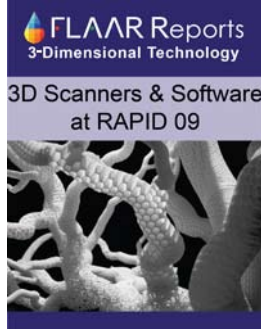
